COLCHESTER, Charles Abbot, Lord, kol-ches-ter, was the younger son of the Rev. John Abbot, D.D., rector of All Saints, Colchester, and, in 1775, was elected a student of Christ Church, In 1777 he won the chancellor's medal Oxford. for Latin verse, and in 1783 took his degree as B.C.L., and soon after was called to the bar. In 1795 he left the bar and became clerk of the rules in the Court of King's Bench, and in the same year was returned member of parliament for Helstone, in Cornwall. He now laboured in introducing practical reforms of the law, and the improvement of the public records. In 1800 he obtained leave to bring into the House a bill for taking a census of the population of the kingdom, and the following year the census was taken, and has continued to be taken ever since, decennially. He was now appointed chief secretary for Ireland, and keeper of the Irish

privy seal; but these offices he scarcely held a year, when, in 1802, he was elected speaker of the House of Commons, which he continued to be till 1817, when, in May, a stroke of erysipelas forced him to resign. On the 3rd of June following he was raised to the peerage as Baron Colchester, with a pension of £4000 a year, and £3000 a year to his next successor to the title.
