Gallott returned thanks, on Saturday night, and the announcement of your return to the Management, and the re-engagement of absent favorites, was received with acclamations and three rounds of applause. I have refused to enter into the speculation of the T. R. E. O. B. at which the Performers are very angry, and have refused to engage me on any other terms; if in the course of your Travels you should hear of any thing particularly advantageous

I am at present disengaged. Mr Jones is making up a company for Paris, to play the Operas taken from St W Scotts Novels, and Life in London, adapted to a Parisian audience: he proposes opening in July or August.
