This diary is a record of  
events that concern me and  
arranged by days it is the  
fourth volume of a series that  
began Feb 1 1911

1 August 5 1912  
Sint.

I did not go to school  
today but stayed at home  
and took medicine it  
is still hot but I was not  
so sick as I was yesterday  
I guess I will go to school  
tomorrow it is so hot and  
dry that the corn is  
nearly drying up.

August 5<sup>th</sup> I went to school  
today I soon got in my  
old school bag we are  
away back in our books  
and it is easy it don't  
take me much of my time  
and so the rest I can  
write or do anything I  
want to I stay and the  
heat right at the proper  
time I brought my dinner  
home in my pockets.

2 ~~September~~  
~~August~~ 7

I stayed last night with  
Mrs. Elda Ahernady  
and worked a good while  
on the board this morning  
then I went home and  
read all the evening  
I went down to the office  
a little while and then  
went to the tobacco association  
meeting

August 8 Mrs. Elda went to  
the hayrallers last night  
stayed on the board it was  
12 o'clock when she got home  
I stayed my time on the  
board this morning and  
this evening I slept  
all the evening it  
was a little more pleasant  
today than usual

3 ~~September~~  
~~August~~ 9

today I wrote a letter  
to brother I guess he  
will be glad to hear from  
me I know that he is  
getting homesick I  
wrote some more on my  
Bandon items I am  
going to mail it tomorrow  
August 10 I filed my  
contribution to the paper and  
mailed it. it is cooler  
today than it was yesterday  
I think I am improving  
~~in~~ in my ~~lesson~~ writing  
we are taking exercise  
in writing every day  
that evening I had to do all  
the work up as Harry  
was staying in Mr.  
Pawell's store

4 September 1912

today is pretty warm again though it is a little cool in the morning I did stay on the boat my time today I played ball a little while but there aint much interest here

Sept 17 I stayed up at Cousin Abner last night and this morning it was awful cold a north wind was blowing I went to school and was sick nearly all day I got some old ham and buns potatoes up to Cousin Abner I suppose that is what done it I went home at recess this evening

5 Sept 12 1912

Sept 13

I felt awfully bad today I guess I am having another attack of the some kind of spells which I thought I had just got rid of it is a pain that hurts me a good deal

Sept 13 I did not go to school but stayed at home my fever came up again and I felt terribly bad We got some awfully bad news news today Will Holl is dead he died in Dunns Luerystable I was sitting in the bed and was already sick they had been walking him up and down the streets to keep his heart active and

6 the doctor put something  
in his arm and told  
them to let him sleep  
when they went in to  
see about him he was  
dead poor cousin will he  
had been drinking of  
think

Saturday Sept 18 I  
packed around town.  
tomorrow they are going  
to bury uncles will I  
suppose I will go but  
I dont feel extra good  
I stayed in in the  
oficial ambulance today  
and stayed at home  
Mr George Terry and  
me will go to the burying  
of exeat as I will  
drive ab George to Mr  
Terry's house

7 - Sept 18 I went to  
cousin Wills burying  
today it sure was a  
hard long trip I went  
by myself and drove  
ab George it was  
pretty warm and there  
was an ambul around there  
they had more fine  
flowers they had seven  
hundred dollars worth  
of flowers. I went  
up at Ernest Elliotts  
I felt bad all day I  
started back at three  
thirty and didnt get back  
till about seven thirty  
that night I sure was  
sore and tired Miss Ida  
stayed my time on the  
board for me.

8 Sept ~~16~~ I went to

school today but I was  
so sick that I could not  
stay I had to go home it  
was an account of that  
hard trip yesterday & I  
have got a hard fever and feel  
awful bad

Sept 17 I felt so bad  
that I could not go to  
school this morning I  
don't know whether I  
shall go or not any  
more this week I tried  
to get Paul White over  
the telephone to tell him  
why I did not come  
over there but couldn't  
it rained awful hard  
here today and I could not  
have gone had I felt  
able

9 Sept 18 it rained today

I read and boated around  
home awhile I got a  
letter from brother today  
he likes his job he carries  
a light rod I wish I had  
that good a job at that  
money he may get me a  
place just as soon as  
my school is out

Thursday Sept. 19 1912  
I feel I have the night  
sweats now of sweat at  
night it bothers me awful  
& I am taking running  
now I hope that will help  
me I stayed on the  
board a little longer  
than my time today and  
the board for Miss Eldon to  
go to see Mrs  
Clney Nelson

10 Sept 20 the night  
sweats sure do bother me  
I am going to go to  
Lagenter sometime this  
week and see about  
staying over there  
and going to school  
I'd like if I get a  
good place I will  
stay.

Sept 21 nothing much  
doing stayed in the  
office awhile and played  
bill awhile and then  
poked around home  
there was a big circus  
in town today loaded  
like nearly everybody  
turned out. I was tired  
that night as if it  
had worked all day

11 Sept 22 1912

I stayed my time at the  
board this morning and  
went to Lagenter this  
evening I knocked around  
a good deal and finally  
went to Mr. Fasters  
they could give me a place  
but did not know how  
long it would last so  
I don't believe I will  
take it

Sept 23 a great deal of  
new boys have started to  
school now and it seems  
something like it used  
to I enjoyed myself  
tolerably well today  
and I am feeling  
a whole lot better



12 Sept 24 I got out

brothers all of them  
last night and his  
higher arithmetic I don't  
guess I will get to  
study them much but  
I may study them every  
night

Sept 25 I didn't sleep  
very well last night  
and am not feeling  
so well today we  
are going to take tomorrow  
the last of this week  
I have passed so  
much that I don't guess  
my examination papers  
will run very high  
I don't care though  
I have my diploma

13 Sept. 26 1910

We had examination  
today it sure has  
marked me hard  
my I am tired  
I completed eight  
studies in one day  
I thought that was  
doing some work

Sept 27 Gee  
Why I am as sick  
as a horse that  
taking the examination  
so run me down  
and I feel so bad  
that I just couldn't  
get around at all  
I set up a little  
this evening of  
~~all~~ all the sick  
feelings I have it

I feel a little better today though very little I was able to stay my time on the board today and eat a little things are awful dull though

Sept 29

I boated around home this morning and then went down and stayed my time on the board I stayed on the board till 4:30 and then went down to town there was a good lot of boys and girl there but I didn't play with them

Poyné said I had better not try to go to school and so I am just boating around home today not doing anything in particular

I got 1 I got out a life of Daniel Webster and read in it a little but today it is not very interesting but I am going to read it as I guess I will need it after I get through with it I will read some other ~~big~~ biographies of famous men

16 Sept 2 1912

A nice day I am  
feeling so well now  
I stayed up in the  
office a little while  
this morning I am  
taking exercise I  
walked a good piece  
they say my lungs is  
getting a little better  
Sept 3. I roomed  
around and took a  
good deal of exercise  
I am still reading  
the history of Daniel  
Webster it is a good  
book I feel so  
much better I may  
start in to school  
Monday if I keep  
improving

17 Sept 4 1912

I stayed up in the office  
a good while this morning  
writing on the type  
writer and reading  
and after my time on  
the board was off I  
went in and read  
wrote a good deal  
Miss Ida and Mr. Jan  
are going to take  
their vacation beginning  
tomorrow Mr. Som  
ewells is to stay on  
the board of school  
around in town this  
evening and finally  
come up home and  
read I am going  
to stay down to Mr  
Lons tonight so they can  
get an early start

Oct 6 1912 stayed  
all night up at  
Mr Lano last night  
he got up at three  
thirty they got away  
by daylight & stayed  
on the board all the  
morning and at  
dinner Mr Everts &  
I just walked around  
town the rest of the  
day

Oct 7 today is court  
day I went up in the  
afternoon and stayed  
on bar Mr Mann  
to go to his breakfast  
then I went in the  
court room they  
had several boxes  
and I stayed and heard  
them  
Hughes  
Wardlaw Key

Oct 8 the holy rollers  
or as they call themselves  
pentecost baptists  
are here I am going  
tonight the alarm the  
holy ghost tells  
them what to do  
the joy all sorts of  
things they can roll  
ball down roller and  
almost any old thing.

Oct 9 I went to  
hear the holy rollers  
last night they aint  
doing much yet there  
howent many got  
here yet I stay on  
for Mr Sam to go  
to his meals every  
day fool around  
in the court house and  
everything else

today is a pretty day  
but a little colder  
el stayed and the hours  
awhile this morning  
for me soon to go  
and fix telephones  
el wish el was able to go  
to sahaaf mammy  
may not let me go for  
a good while yet.

Oct 11 el am a little  
bit sick today el have  
got fever it looks  
as if el cant get rid  
of it Miss Franne  
brought me a nice  
dinner also Miss J.  
Cvetts sent me a  
nice bowl of oyster  
soup.

I am a good seal  
better today than I  
was el holed around  
town here today this  
is a dull place el rest  
awhile at home

Oct 12 today is a  
nice day a what lot of  
people around here are  
going hahard and near  
hunting they say there  
are lots of them down  
in the bottom el went  
to the holy rollers last  
night and am going  
again today tonight  
they got happy last night  
hugged and kissed sang  
and hollered as loud as they  
could el dont know how  
long they are going to stay here

22 at 13 / 1912

I packed around home this morning and when I got down there Miss Eldo had come home Mr. Larr had to go to St. Louis because his aunt was sick and Miss Eldo just came on home

at 14 Miss Eldo has taken the board book now I stayed all night with her last night and packed around today it seems after meals as if I ought to go right back to the board as I am in the habit

23 at 15 / 1912

I helped around home early this morning then Miss Eldo phoned me to come down to the board she is expecting company this evening and is cleaning up her house

at 16 I went to school this morning a great many scholars have started since I quit I think I am well enough to study now. I feel all right all the classes are way ahead of where they were when I quit school

24

Oct 17 it is

raining a cold  
rain this morning  
it is very dismal  
I went to school though  
I am studying higher  
arithmetic instead  
of the regular arithmetic  
it is a good deal harder  
than the elementary  
but I think I can  
complete it

Oct 18 I feel as if  
I couldn't go to school  
as I have a nervous  
attack, it is awful  
my break came today  
Miss G. stayed on  
the board in my  
place I could not eat  
anything all day

25 Oct 19 I feel a

little better today but  
my head still aches  
I worked my time on  
the board however but  
never went back in  
the office as I  
intended I fooled  
around town a while  
and then went home

Oct 20 I stayed  
my time on the board  
this morning it  
is awfully cold  
and I like to have  
frost going down  
there this evening I  
went down town but  
didn't stay long I  
soon came home and  
read up here by the  
fire

26

at 21 I foaled

around the office today writing on the typewriter and reading it is still pretty cold but the sun makes it tolerably warm Mr Reeser takes the literary Digest that is a good paper

at 22 nothing much doing had a good breakfast last night though it was hot & killing and Cousin Tell has had gathered his corn I wish he would we are nearly out

27

at 23 I foaled around

town this morning and leaves Mr Willy Roy over to Locater this evening I ~~didn't~~ didn't see any of the folks it was a real drive coming back a cloud came up but it didn't rain I had to feed and water the horse ~~bes~~

Thursday at 24 I stayed up in the office a good while today I did not feel so well to say as I have been feeling



28 Oct 25

today is a awfully  
mal day I stayed  
most of my time on  
the board and stayed  
up in the office a little  
while

Oct 24 I faaled around  
home this morning  
and come just one thing  
and then another brother  
come home today I was  
certainly glad of it we  
need him Roy did not come  
with him he is  
coming home Christmas  
the sickly season is  
an and brother said he  
was afraid of being sick  
his pay was deapressed  
all the time he last  
also

29 Oct 27 I stayed my

time on the board this  
evening an Alton boy  
got drunk and rode  
his horse over the  
roadment I didnt know  
what on earth was

happening when I heard  
him Mr Lam went  
peach hunting today  
Oct 28 today is a dull  
day I read and wrote  
on the typewriter the  
Ballard County bank has  
lost its suit against  
the bonding company  
and I guess its  
furniture will soon  
be sold I may buy  
the typewriter I have  
fifteen dollars

Oct 29 today is

just a week before  
election I am pretty  
confident that Wilson will  
be elected brother  
has hired Edgar Rogland  
to help him cut wood  
I am just beginning  
to realize that my  
sickness had some  
good effect after all.

Oct 30 today is a  
bad day it is misting  
rain brother is nearly  
sick and they did not  
cut wood after dinner  
today. after staying on  
the board, I wrote in the  
affair awhile and fooled  
around town.

Oct 31 Thursday not

much doing today wrote  
up in the affair awhile  
today.

~~Oct~~ Nov. 1 this is the  
eleventh month time  
is flying fast it seems  
to me was president  
Sherman is dead  
he died of brights  
disease.

Nov. 2 I guess I will  
start into school  
Monday, I feel a great  
deal better I have to  
be cured pretty soon  
Nov 3 stayed my time  
on the board this  
morning it is awful  
cold and I hate to get  
out in it.

32

Nov. 4 it is a little warmer today tomorrow is election and there is a good deal of excitement the papers concede that Wilson is elected

Nov. 5 today is election day and everybody has turned out & never seen anything like it the negroes turned out in droves Bandana went democratic of course Wilson 130 to 67 D. L. Roosevelt 0 only three tickets

received any votes at all the other three were beat badly

33

Nov. 6 I started to school this morning the bulletins give Wilson nearly all the states excepted of that, a whole lot of us have clubbed in and bought a football it will be in tomorrow

Nov. 7 the football has come & am the manager of one team I did not feel so well today Miss Ansel is pretty strict I don't get talk for a week.

Nov. 8 today Moses the second time we have beat Ansel side in the history class we did it easy

34 Nov. 9 I stayed on

the board all day  
I felt a little bit  
had today Mr Reems  
Miss also brother come  
down and they went  
recess hunting

Sunday Nov. 10 I  
felt so had today  
brother stayed part of  
my time on the  
board Miss also  
to ather I slept nearly  
all day

Monday Nov 11 I am better  
today went to school and

pretty warm day

straight in the history  
class

Cooler today played  
foot ball in this  
morning my side  
beat the show was  
written by Robert  
Witty I wish I  
could write that  
Well I am about  
to freeze

36 Nov 15 last night

was the coldest that we  
have had we are calling  
a hog today I am  
certainly glad of it  
Jan 16 I stayed my  
time on the board  
this morning and walked  
around the evening  
I played football a  
little while it is  
cold at night but warm  
in the mudday

Nov 17 I stayed my time  
on the board this  
morning and played  
football in the  
evening I went to  
Rube Everett's and got  
a bushel of turnips  
yesterday they sure are  
fine

37 Nov 18 real day

Bob Witty is shaking  
the seat that makes  
my handwriting very  
sloppy I am feeling  
a little bit better I  
guess I will have to

Nov 19 a real day  
I am feeling better  
today and myself  
are studying Physical

Nov 20 real day poppy  
and mother are  
cutting wood today  
it is to be  
cold today I am glad  
that we are getting  
up our wood it will  
soan get hot and

38 Nov 21 we are taking examination today I made a hundred an solving the examination is easy we took some studies today

Nov. 22 still taking examination I made a hundred 90 in geography physiology and anatomy the more is the better made it will win the 90+

Nov 23 I cut wood today with Panno and brother and went to the teacher's meeting this evening I am going to stay on the board

39 Nov 24 I stayed my time on the board this evening it is very good Nov 25 I felt a little bit bad today but went to school there is going to be a play at Loventer tonight I may go

Nov 26 I am already sick this morning however I went to school brother and myself are cutting wood and I have to do up all the work it took me till dark

40 Nov 27 1915

today is cold it took  
me so long to get  
the work done up  
that it was today  
we are going to have  
a debate tomorrow  
night

Nov 28 Thank's Giving  
day of am feeling  
pretty bad we have  
not off the debate  
till tomorrow  
night we had a real  
thanksgiving dinner  
and stayed down  
town and wrote  
a while on the

here.

Dec 17 and well till Christmas I am not expecting any great Christmas presents but right after us for being gone so long when we went after water

50 Dec 18 Robbil

and myself made  
a resolution to be  
good today we have  
been tolerable good  
all day parum and

Dec 19 it has  
turned cold we

It snowed today a steady snow all day & stayed down at Miss Eds last night. Mr Jan left yesterday but he came back today.

Dec 24 it has stopped snowing but it is awful cold it does not seem much like Christmas but there is lots of drinking in town & bought all of the kids a few presents & had to go down and stay with Miss Eds awhile Mr Jan & Bernathy has gone to Lalla Bernathy's wedding.

53 Dec 25 Tuesday

This aint much like Christmas used to be today there was the awfullest fight of eyes heard of Tee Redfern shot and killed Express Williams full stopped Tee and George Redfern and Tee Redfern shot. But in the shoulder nothing serious however etant Williams murder. they had an inquest today and have locked Tee Redfern to jail.

59 Jan 9 1913

it is awful cold today Brother is working out to Cousin Earls today and I have all the work to do Jan 10 I went to school this morning, but Mr Jim Reed came after me to help him take down the snow. I came home at dinner my fountain pens come today I have them in an ice bag in a self filler. Miss Anise wants one of them.

Edo has the loggers  
and I stayed at the  
board amnio for her
