

As soon as weather permits and Rodney McKinney can set it up in his schedule of work, we will want to mark off the main street for parallel parking to follow the plan which you drew up and we went over several days ago.

The plan is to be followed as drawn up except that we will retain angle parking as discussed between the post office steps and the small step leading to the walk opposite the Clubhouse entrance. We will also mark off the extra parking areas that we located near the filling station, at the rear of the telephone building and south of the office. I also have one or two other spots in mind, where I believe we can gain one or two parking spaces. I can show you these when the painting is started.

The new plan of parking provides space for only two parking meters in front of the community building. We will want to maintain six parking meter spaces, and I think we can designate these after the street has been marked off under the new layout.
