Dear Mr. Bradford:


Your request for a bath addition has been approved. We can begin work very soon if you are willing to accept a monthly rent increase of \$1.00, making your total monthly rent \$25.00.

The total monthly rent mentioned above does not include the monthly charge made for floor furnaces. If you now have a furnace, please add \$3.00 to this figure.

If this is acceptable, please see the rent clerk, Mr. Gore, at the main office and sign a new house lease incorporating the rent increase. The rent increase will not become effective until all the work is completed.

It is necessary that we set a time limit in which you have to sign a new lease. If you have not signed the new lease by office closing time, November 1, we will assume that you no longer want the improvement made to your house, in which event we will assign the money now allotted to your house to make improvements for some other tenant.
