

Leonard Hall as a working foreman looking after the men who work on the construction of the additions to the houses, under Special Appropriation No. 163, will receive a straight time rate of \$1.35 per hour and an overtime rate of \$2.025 per hour.

Hall and his men will work eight hours per day and will take out thirty minutes for lunch for which they will not be paid. The carpenters working under Hall will receive \$1.25 per hour. Hall and his men will receive the straight time rate for the first five days or the first forty hours in a week and premium pay of time and one-half or rate and one-half after forty hours or for the sixth consecutive work day of a week.

The only reason we are allowing Hall premium pay of time and one-half after forty hours is because he is a working foreman and we will expect him to function in that manner.
