Dear Henry:

In accordance with your recent proposal, we will contract with you for the inspection of the refrigeration equipment shown on the attached list under the following terms and conditions:

- 1- A monthly inspection will be made of each refrigeration unit shown on the attached list, the inspection to consist of oiling motor, cleaning air cooled condensers, checking for leaks and noises, checking belts, brushes, vibration, gas, internal oil, water flow, valves, switches and temperature.
- 2- The inspections are to be made as nearly as possible about the same time each month, and we will pay you \$1 per unit per month for the inspection.
- 3- You are to make any repairs that are necessary to the refrigeration units shown on the attached list and you will charge us for all labor and material in making such repairs at the established cost prices for material and at the established rates for labor. In addition, we will pay you mileage of five cents per mile in coming to Wheelwright and making the repairs. There is, however, to be no charge for mileage for your regular inspections.
- 4- This letter contract can be cancelled by the Osborne Bros. Refrigeration Service or by the Inland Steel Company by written notice to the other party seven days in advance of day of cancellation.
