Gentlemen:

We are shipping to you today via the C & O Railway Company the Safety Bulletin Board.

Instead of sending this knocked-down and nested so that all parts would have to be assembled on arrival, we are shipping it set up with all cabinets attached to the background. Upon arrival the only thing necessary will be to provide the back braces holding it to the wall or posts on which it is to be placed.

As a foundation on which to attach this bulletin we suggest that upright braces be placed in back of the edges of the masonite where they butt as well as the rectangle that you will put back of the red, white, and blue molding.

The masonite can be nailed or screwed securely to these upright members after the board has been erected.
