The sales tax will, of course, apply to all merchandise sold at the store, but in this case the tax will be passed on to the customer. From what I now know about the tax bill, a number of reports will have to be propared and submitted to the Revenue Department at Frankfort. Between now and July I, you should work out the necessary procedure at the store for collection of the tax and the necessary accounting to maintain proper record of the collections. As I obtain more definite information concerning the tax and its application, I will pass the information on to you. Manager Coal Properties CC: FEConley SBenedict Sonny, Chick, Steve: The sales tax will apply to any supply house materials sold to individuals. It will also apply to any materials sold from Buildings and Grounds Department stock and materials and machinery on hand in other departments, regardless of the class and condition of such material and equipment. The 3 per cent tax applied to such materials sold will, of course, be in the form of a reimbursement or credit to Inland.
