This is Item No. 9 of the August 19 letter referred to above. Sub-paragraph B of Item (9) in part contains the following instructions: "On trucks coming from Wheelwright to be weighed, Hunter Thomas will cail the Shipping Clerk, who will in turn notify the weighmaster. The clapsed driving time from Wheelwright to the scales at Price is to be noted on the weight ticket." It has come to my attention that this part of the instructions has been neglected, and this memorandum is to insist that the instructions be carried out just as specified in the letter of August 19.
