It was pointed out that this was due to the back of drainage from the conduit and manholes at the rear of the office, store and colored recreation buildings. This is not the first time we have you difficulty in this section of our telephone system due to the lack of drainage and I feel some steps should be made to correct it to prevent Suture failures from this cause.
