TRAINING GROUP SCHEDULE

WHEELWRIGHT OPERATION

AUGUST 8-11, 1955

MONDAY

- 8:00 A. M. Report at Manager's office.
- 8:30 A. M. Report to Mine Superintendent's office where mining plans of area to visit underground will be discussed. The group will then proceed to the Wheelwright portal. From the portal mine jeeps will transport the group to sections in the No. 3 Mains area. The party will go to section B-21 to see the Colmol and visit section 7 where they will observe the 12RB cutting machine and the 14BU-8 loader. (Lunch to be eaten underground)
- The underground party will be in charge of E. M. Pace, Mine Superintendent; W. F. Hughes, General Mine Foreman and Elford Roberts, Mining Engineer.
- 2:00 - 3:00 P. M. Visit the main shop facilities. George Leatherman, Superintendent of Power and Mechanical Department, will conduct the party and will explain the equipment, where necessary, and outline the services which his department renders in the over-all picture.

TUESDAY

- 8:00 - 11:00 A. M. Visit the Preparation Plant, supply house, laboratory, Service Center, East side and aerial tram. Robert Smith, Plant Superintendent, will conduct the party with the assistance of Bob Grimm, Preparation Engineer.
- 1:00 - 3:00 P. M. Visit the hospital, stores, filter plant, swimming pool, golf club. Rodney McKinney, Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, will conduct the party and will explain the general setup. The doctors will meet the party at the hospital to answer any questions, and the Store Manager will be available at the store.
