



# WALTER NEWMAN HALDEMAN

HONORARY MEMBER ORPHAN BRIGADE

Born, Maysville, Ky., April 27, 1821; schoolmate of Gen. U. S. Grant. Came to Louisville in 1839; started a publication in 1843, which became the Courier; Surveyor of the Port under President Buchanan; when the war came, went South with the Courier; helped in every way the soldiers from Kentucky; returned to Louisville in 1865, resumed publication, which changed to Courier-Journal in 1868; led in giving to every good cause; died at 4:30 A. M., May 13, 1902, the greatest philanthropist in the South.
