An adjourned meeting of the Faculty convened at 2:30 p.m. of above date, to consider further the report of The Committee on Post-graduate Degrees. Prof. White, Chairman of the Committee read the report in full. Dr. Kastle moved to take up the report for consideration, sec. by sec. Carried. Prof. Pence moved that the Degrees named be written out in full, as well as expressed by abbreviations. Carried.

Prof. Pence moved a substitute for the first section of the report, requiring one year's resident work, if the course taken should include laboratory work. This was lost. The first section then carried as reported.

The other sections, after full discussion and various amendments, were adopted. (See File B, Report 14, for both original and amended report.)
