

Dining Room

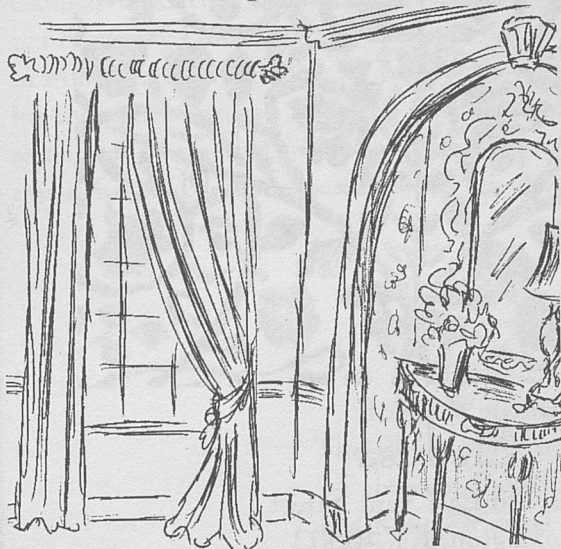

The Regency style demi lunes, below the Chippendale style mirror and against the reproduction gold Chinese wall-covering, are reminiscent of the original interior design of the dining room. The mirrors feature antique mercury glass.

The rug is a 100-year-old Oushak. The Chippendale chairs feature a custom finish called antique cream crackle. The framed antique rose silk wedding jacket is the basis of the color scheme for the silk draperies, as well as the collection of old and reproduction Chinese and English porcelains.

The room also features silver leaf obelisks and vases. The elegant impressionistic painting of the lady in formal dinner dress hangs above the English walnut sideboard. The side chairs are covered in an espresso-colored Indian silk lapas to complement the raw silk gold color of the walls.
