The entry hall welcomes visitors and sets the tone of the house. The walls are done in a cream and sage green Venetian plaster and are finished with an umber glaze. This creates a warm, inviting look for the space. Beautiful antique furniture, accessories, and wonderful antique oriental rugs further enhance the feeling of this space. Antique oriental rugs on the stair landing and on the second floor continue the traditional elegance. A grouping of four closet doors at the top of the stairs presents a perfect place for murals within the three panels on each

door. These murals reflect the love of seashells that was so important to George Headley, the man who built and lived in this house.
