Humphrey May and bound as follows (to wit) Beginning at a sugar tree on the South side of Back of lick Creek and thence W 50 poles to a stake in Chriss line thence with the same South 22 W 14 8 poles to a Beach and dogwood thence South 82 W 98 p^l to a sugar tree
