1780 } Joseph Craig Enters 1000 Acres upon a Treasury warrant on
a west fork of Licking about 2 miles below where Capt.
Bowman encamped the second night when Marching to the
Shawnee Towns to include the forks of the Creek running
up and down for quantity.

May 17

1780 } John Hayden Enters 5000 Acres upon a Treas-
-ury warrant joining Joseph Craig on the North fork
of the S^d Creek running up both sides thereof for quantity
Joining the said Craig on the upper side.

May 17

1780 } John Coleman Enters 5000 Acres upon a Treasury
warrant adjoining Joseph Craig on the lower side on
the creek and ^{down} the creek on both sides for quantity.

17 May

1780 } John Hutcherson Enters 1000 Acres upon a Treasury
warrant joining John Coleman on the lower side and
running down both sides of the said creek for quantity.

May 17

1780 } Ben Stephens Enters 5000 Acres upon a Treasury
warrant on a branch running in on the South side
of the creek that Joseph Craigs Entry lies on.
Beginning at Joseph Craigs line and running up
both sides of the branch for quantity.
