Irregularities

At a meeting of the Executive Committee of the State University of Kentucky held at the President's Office on the ____ day of September, 1913, there were present the following: Messrs. C. B. Nichols, T. L. Edelen, C. B. Terrell and Hywel Davies.

Professor Anderson recommended that Professor J. J. Curtis' salary be increased \$200.00 for the current year, and that the salary of Professor J. R. Duncan be increased \$100.00 for the current year. Upon motion made and seconded and roll called the motion carried unanimously.

Mesers. Nichols and Davies reported that they had made a contract with the Kinkead Coal Company for a supply of coal up to May first, 1914, at the following rates.

Round or Egg Coal \$2.85 per ton Pear, Not and Slack Coal \$2.30 per ton

Many other matters were discussed but no further business was transacted.
