

HEADQUARTERS 318TH ARMY AIR FORCES FLYING TRAINING DETACHMENT AVENGER FIELD

Sweetwater, Texas February 13, 1943

SUBJECT: Transfer of a part of Class 43-H, to 318th Army Air Forces Training Detachment, Avenger Field, Sweetwater, Texas.

TO : Commanding Officer, San Antonio Aviation Cadet Center, San Antonio, Texas.

- 1. Headquarters, Army Air Forces Gulf Coast Training Center, has informed us that ninety (90) members of Class 43-H are being transferred to this Station for Primary Training.
- 2. It is requested that each Aviation Cadet so transferred be given a copy of these instructions:
- a. All baggage, mail and telegrams will be addressed with the individual cadet's name, Class 43-H, Aviation Cadet Detachment, Avenger Field, Sweetwater, Texas.
- b. Aviation cadets will be met upon arrival at the Railroad Station by a commissioned officer and will transported directly to the post. There is a Western Union sub-station located on the post, and no telegrams will be sent upon arrival by aviation cadets from the Sweetwater Railroad Station.
- c. Aviation cadets will report in wool slacks, khaki shirt and tie, and service cap.
- d. Each aviation cadet will have with him upon arrival, one copy of travel orders.
- e. Aviation cadets travelling by privately owned conveyance will report to the Commandant of Cadets at this Station, located approximately four miles West of the town of Sweetwater, Texas, at 1000 o'clock on February 17, 1943.
- f. Aviation cadets who are married are not encouraged to bring their wives to Sweetwater; housing conditions in such city are inadequate, and the time of duty will not permit frequent visits with wives.
- g. Aviation cadets will be restricted to the Post for a period of approximately two weeks after arrival and will not submit requests for special passes during that time.
