Add/Drop ushers students in for new year

Add/Drop is a sure sign to the summer's end and the beginning of the fall semester.

Add/Drop begins Tuesday, Aug. 27 at the mezzanine of the Patterson Office Tower and runs through sept. 4. Graduate students and seniors will be able to participate first, from 8 to 10 a.m.

Traditionally scheduled last in the Add/Drop process, freshmen will be able to alter their schedules from 10 a.m. to noon. Add/Drop will be closed from noon to 1 p.m.

Juniors will be next from 1 to 3 p.m., followed by sophomores from 3 to 5 p.m. and non-degree students from 5 to 6 p.m.

Lisa Collins, director of registration, said students should be aware that they cannot go to Add/Drop earlier than their allotted time. Those who cannot come at their

After Tuesday Add/Drop will operate on a first-come first-serve basis. The Registration Center, on the mezzanine of POT, will remain open until 7 p.m. on the first day of Add/Drop. Collins said students should bring a pen or pencil, a schedule book and a copy of the Add/Drop edition of the Kentucky Kernel. She advises students to know which classes they want to add and drop. Students also should have their schedule worksheets filled out completely before entering the Add/Drop site.

Students who want to drop a class without adding one may do so in Whitehall Classroom Building. Duplicate fall schedules will be available in 206 Ezra Gillis Building.

Students will have to walk around fences and find new shortcuts to reach buildings on the campus for the next couple years. Construction behind the engineering quadrangle and the Enoch J. Grehan Journalism Building is expected to take at least two years. The construction, which began over the summer, will take up parking space on the central campus from Erickson Hall to the journalism building and will inhibit through traffic in that area. Students will not be allowed to walk through the construction area.





But as UK football coach Bill



"We'll shot for it now," Curry said. "But we are not going to look for a quick fix or instant results or instant success. We seek habitual winning. His debut as a wildcat last year produced a 4-7 season and new sense of urgency. Kentucky football yearns to be a winner now. Nevertheless, Curry again shuns the quick fixers. "There is no pill or bottle that gives you that," Curry said of overnight success. "Don't believe those commercials. You cannot ride out into the Sahara and roll out a swimming pool and good-looking women. You can't do it."

Curry has never forgotten his experience as player with the Green Bay Packers or later with the Baltimore Colts.

He speaks of his fabled peers and mentors often and in detail. With Curry, it's habitual. Lombardi, Bart Starr and Don Shula loom as large to Curry at UK in 1991 as they did in Green Bay and Baltimore more than 20 years ago.






