The faculty of State University met in regular session March 3, 1916, in the faculty room of the Gymnasium. Quorum present. In the absence of President Barker, Professor Miller presided.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. The Committee appointed to make a report on Lieutenant Underwood's motion requiring law students to drill were granted further time.

The Secretary called attention to the faculty rule that the next regular meeting will be the last date for presenting names of candidates for honorary degrees.

The following motion was presented by Professor Mathews:

" An excerpt of the faculty rulings regarding the conduct of dances as adopted on December the third, nineteen hundred and fifteen, be sent by the Secretary to all student organizations with the statement that <sup>no</sup> modifications have been made in these regulations, and that all students of the University are therefore expected to observe them."

On motion of Dr. Tigert, it was voted to refer Professor Mathews' resolution to the Committee on Entertainments - Non-Athletic with power to act.

On recommendation of Dean Lafferty, the following names were presented to the faculty as candidates for the degree - LL.B. :
