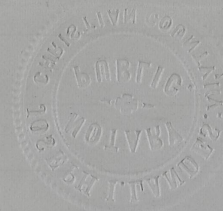
Apprised you by July 12. 79

The undersigned states that some time, to the best of his recollection between the years 1855 & 1860 he paid to the funds of Ky University two hundred & fifty ^(\$250.00) dollars and that a certificate of said payment properly endorsed was issued to him with coupons attached which entitled him to tuition in said University to the amount of said Certificate and Coupons. That thirty of said Coupons were given to his Son J. B. Poinexter when he entered as a Student in the University in 1859, and that no other amount was ever used or transferred by him. And now being desirous that the remainder of the amount (two hundred and twenty dollars) should be applied to the use and benefit of his Grandson Arthur C. Poinexter and this Certificate with other valuable papers having been destroyed during the late war and there is no probability of ever recovering the original, the Curators & proper officers of Ky University on being requested and authorized to issue duplicate Certificate and Coupons to Mrs. Jennie Poinexter Mother of said Arthur C. Poinexter as trustee for said Arthur that here the necessary transfer made on the books of the University for his use and benefit
