that we John B. Bowman Principal
A. H. Bowman & D. M. Bowman Juniors
oblige ourselves to the Curators of
Ky University in the sum of One
Hundred thousand dollars well
and truly to be paid, we bind our
severes, our Heirs Executors and
Administrators jointly and severally
to said Curators this 27th of January
1874 - The condition of this obligation
is such that if said John B. Bowman
shall well and truly discharge all
his duties as Treasurer of Kentucky
University and account for and pay over
all funds received by him or now in
his hands, and in all things discharge
all his duties as Treasurer as aforesaid
according to law, then this obligation
to be void else to be and remain in
full force and effect.
