

This Indenture made and entered into
this 2^d day of August 1863 between John
Locke late Sheriff of Daviess County
of the one Part and James Rudd of
the County of Jefferson & State of Kentucky
of the other Part witnesseth that whereas
an Execution issued from the clerks office
of the Daviess Circuit Court against
James C. Rudd in favor of W.C. Morris
for the sum of \$111.15 with interest from
the 1st April 1861 until paid & \$1.80 cost and
one against the same in favor of J.H. Clugman
for the sum of \$398.11 with interest from
the 13th day of January 1861 & \$1.80 cost and one in
favor of Wm. P. Bell & against the same
for the sum of \$199.15 with interest from
the 12th day of July 1861 & \$1.80 cost which
executions were directed & delivered to said
Locke Sheriff as aforesaid & were by him levied
upon a certain lot of ground & house after
described. And the said Rudd failing
to execute bond for the payment of said
executions the said property was duly
advertised & appraised and the said
Locke did on the 12th day of May 1863
proceed to expose the same to public
auction at the Court House door in
Owensboro when when James Rudd the
party of the ~~second~~ being the highest bidder
became the purchaser thereof at for the
sum of \$3425.00 which amount was paid
in the hand and now the party of the first
part for and in consideration of the said
sum of Ninety seven hundred twenty five
