here this season, and now we no longer
feel any apprehension of its appearance.

agents New Orleans - for Dr. G. W. Peete
Gaunston. In the business matter
I shall proceed immediately to
qualify, attempt to arrange the debt
and save as much of it as I
possibly can. If ~~had~~ I had but one
thousand dollars, besides what I can
spare myself, it would aid me very
much, as I shall have to pay a
large percentage for what I borrow.

My family will return to the city - about
the 1st of Nov. All well - Give my love
to Willie, and for yourself accept my
kindest regards
