willingly seal and deliver said writing and wishes not to retract it; and again
acknowledged s^d writing shewd and explained to her by me, to be her act and
deed, and Consented that the same may be recorded = Whereupon said

of Estill County Court, in which County the premises hereby conveyed lie. =
