

Survey No. 68. --Madison Co.

Madison, Set. --May 26th, 1798. --Surveyed for Higerson Grubbs, assee of Cartwright, assee of Zachariah Clark, 100 acres of land part of an entry for 1950 acres and upon part of a treasury warrant No. 9397, situate, lying on the South side of Kentucky River, adjoining of Robt. Clark's survey of 7000 acres on the upper side. Bounded as followeth, viz.:

Beginning at the said Clark's upper corner on the river bank, a walnut hackberry and hickory trees at A.; thence with said Clark's line South till it strikes the Kentucky River

240 poles to a stake on the bank of the river at B.:

thence down the river the meanders thereof to the beginning.

Scale 200 poles.

Variation 4° East.
