W.S.Allen (Amx heirs) 400-Acre Tract.

Description of Land from Calls of Original Deed  
to Company.

Two certain tracts of land lying in Breathitt County, Kentucky, on the Winna Branch of Quicksand, the first tract containing a hundred acres, and is the same land patented to Allen Craft by Patent No.40265, bearing date Sept.30,1867. The second tract containing 200 acres, and is the same land granted to Allen Craft by Patent No.40266, bearing date Sept. 30, 1867, to which said patents and a deed from Allen Craft to said W.S.Allen, of record in Deed Book No.3, pages 274, 275 and 276, Breathitt County records, reference is had for more definite distinctions.

Also, a certain tract or parcen of land said to contain 100 acres more or less, lying on the Winna Branch above and adjoining the aforementioned two tracts.

By this deed Allen agrees to deed the land above described, and a hundred acres additional on demand of the Company, title to the last 100 acres not having been completed at the date of the deed, April 21st, 1888.
