

Clay County August 5<sup>th</sup> 1812

It is known that J. John Haddix having  
had an agreement or say two agreements with  
C. Cotton myself and John Anderson for the purpose  
of making salt on the land of John Obannon which  
I conceive to be an Equal Interest with said Cotton  
and Obannon after giving Phelps his Interest  
which <sup>Interest or</sup> Contract with Phelps was understood  
to be one half said Obannons entire Interest  
originally on the land.

but what ever Interest I may have I do hereby  
relinquish the same to said Cotton his heirs  
and assigns, and bind myself to fulfil  
the Contract or Agreement as it respects  
finishing the well on or before the first  
day of October next John Haddix
