Final Statistics Show Kentucky Players Ranked High In 1951 Conference Race But All-Time Record Is Not So Good

They haven't taken the air out of all the footballs at the Coliseum. That keeps in order the right to look through the Southeastern Conference 1951 Football Statistics to see how the Wild-cast Fared mathematically with their opponents.

The book is published annually through the co-operation of the sports publicity office of each school. This year it is compiled by Joe Sherman of Florida.

Babe Parilli, whose sharpshooting records have surpassed those of D. Boone, naturally led all SEC passers as his tosses netted 1643 yards and 19 touchdowns. (Two TD passes in the Cotton Bowl are excluded.) He completed 136. Bill Wade of Vandy ranked behind Parilli and Georgia's Zeke Bratkowski ran third.


