- The State joined me at

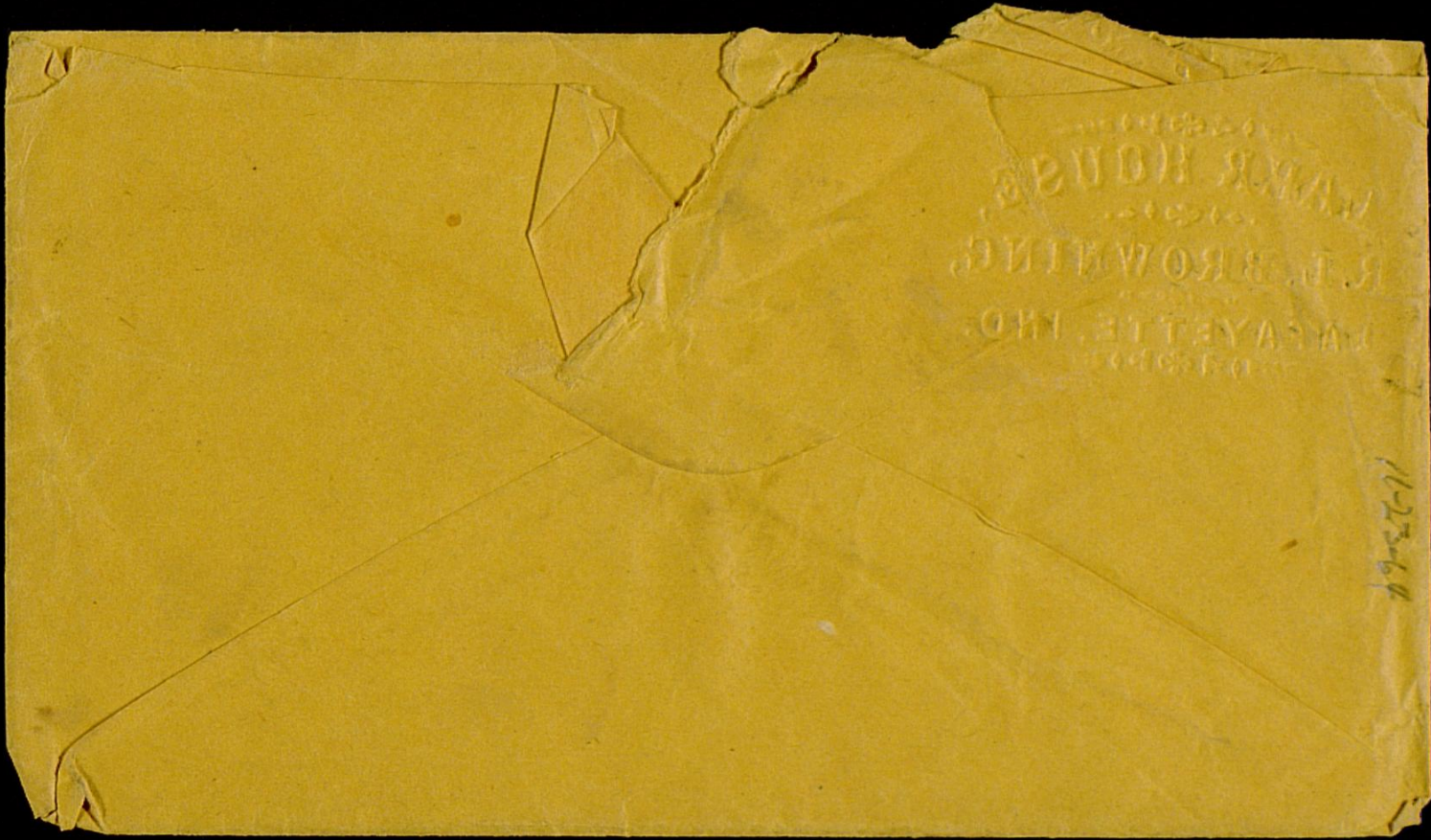
the Burnett today and
