

Minutes of the meeting of a special committee of the Board of Trustees, University of Kentucky, on Thursday, August 21, 1930.

The University of Kentucky held its first graduation exercises for summer school students at the close of the summer session on Friday, August 22, 1930. The chairman of the Executive Committee, Judge Stoll, designated the following committee to pass on the candidates: James Park, Louis Hillenmeyer, E. B. Webb. The Committee was called to meet on Thursday, August 21, 1930 in the President's office at the University at 11:00 o'clock. Mr. Webb reported, but the other two members were unable to attend the meeting. In their absence, the Registrar, E. L. Gillis, and W. S. Taylor, Director of the Summer Session, met with the Committee and passed a resolution approving the recommendation of the University Senate in which certain candidates were recommended for degrees. The following is a list of the candidates recommended by the University Senate and approved by the special committee.

It is understood that this action is subject to confirmation of the Board of Trustees at its meeting in September.
