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FOREWORD

A review of the accreditation of elementary schools of the state for the school year 1974-75 continues to indicate that major progress is being made in most areas of elementary education.

Progress in the various areas reflects the great concern that elementary personnel have for meeting the individual needs of children. The importance of this concern is shown by improvement in the following areas:

- ✓Expansion of curriculum offerings
- ✓Increase of experimental programs
- ✓Greater variety of teaching procedures and techniques
- ✓The use of various teaching aids has greatly increased during recent years

Elementary schools with eight or more teachers are classified as Extended, Standard, Basic or Approved. Appropriate standards and criteria adopted by the State Board of Education are written into regulations for accrediting the elementary schools.

You will note that there are still relatively few schools classified as Extended but you will also observe an increase in the number of Standard schools and a decrease in the number of Basic schools.

We trust this bulletin will be helpful to both elementary school personnel and others striving for a qualitative elementary school for each child in Kentucky.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 1974-75

There were 1,082 elementary schools accredited by the State Board of Education during the school year 1974-75. Of this number 755 were under the control of the county school districts and 196 were under the control of the independent districts. Nineteen (19) were state or federal and 112 were private schools.

Table I below shows the number of accredited elementary schools classified according to the type of control for five years from 1970-71 to 1974-75.

The total number of elementary schools operating in Kentucky including all of the elementary schools of seven teachers and below as well as the 1,082 accredited schools, numbered 1,316 schools. Of this number, there were 14 one-teacher schools compared to 24 one-teacher schools last year.

Table II gives the enrollment in the accredited elementary schools according to the grades and the control under which the school operated.

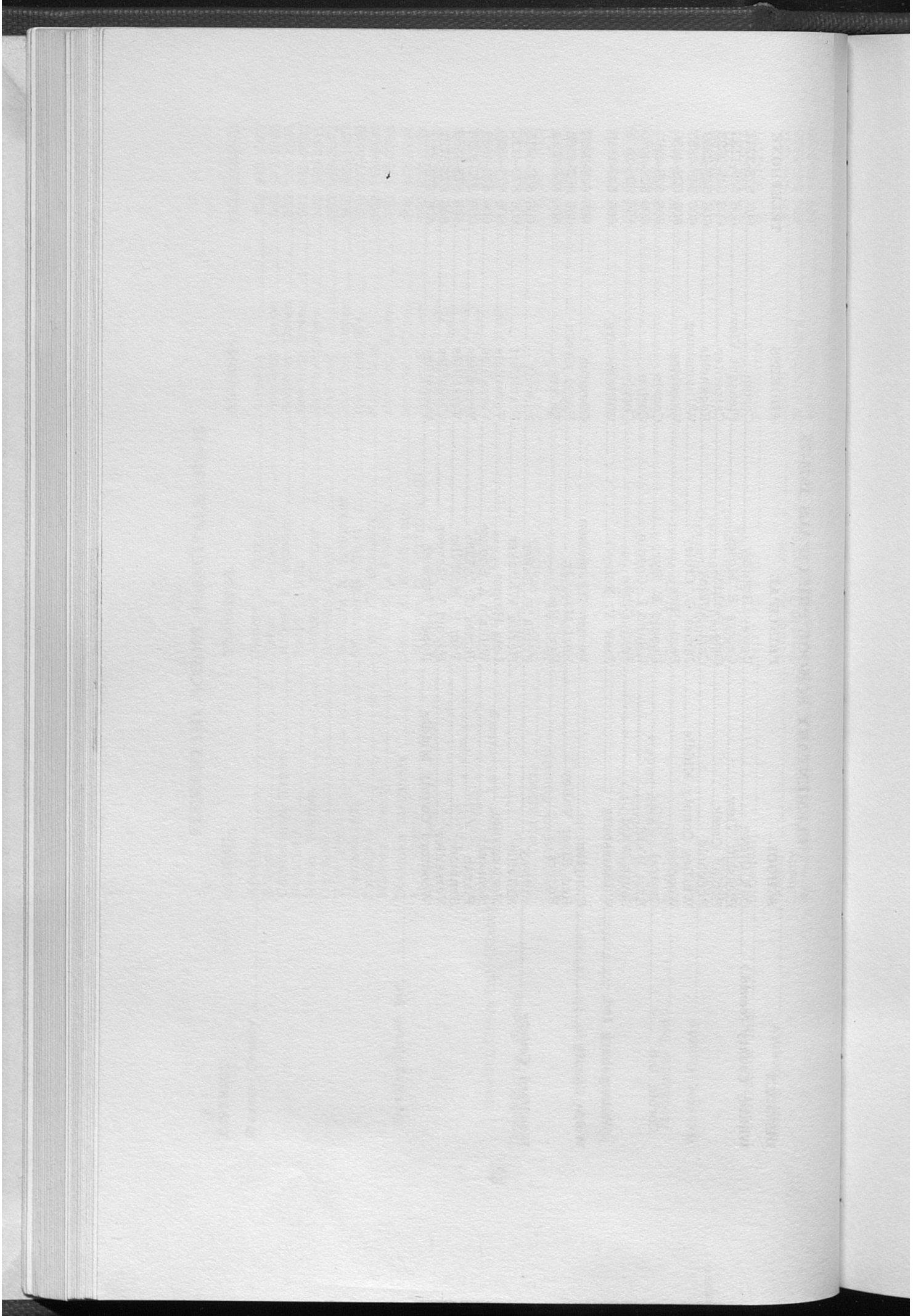
