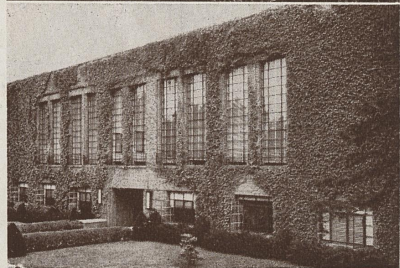

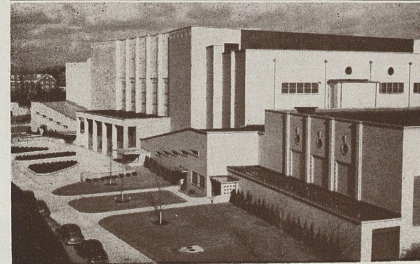
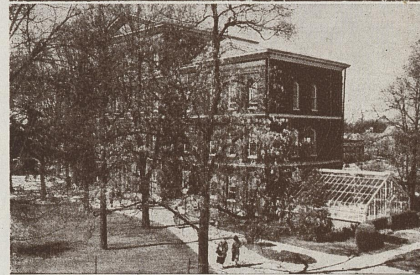
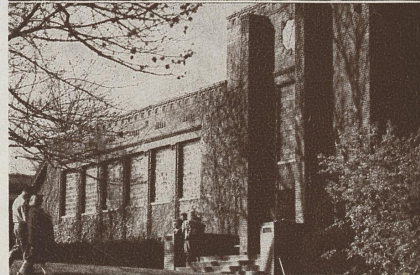
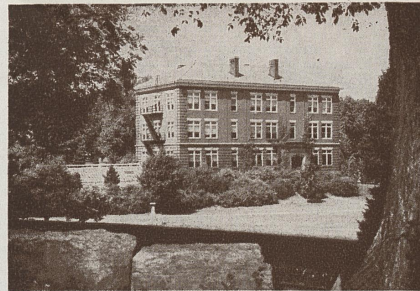
With its own post office, book store, library, radio station, newspaper, theatre, bowling lanes, police force, and hospital, the University is a small city in itself. The main campus, just a few minutes walk from downtown Lexington, is composed of 145 acres, while the adjoining Experiment Station farm has 561 acres. There are more than fifty major structures on the campus. Popular attractions include the Fine Arts Building, Memorial Coliseum, Margaret I. King Library, Student Union Building, Memorial Hall, and the Museums of Anthropology and Zoology.

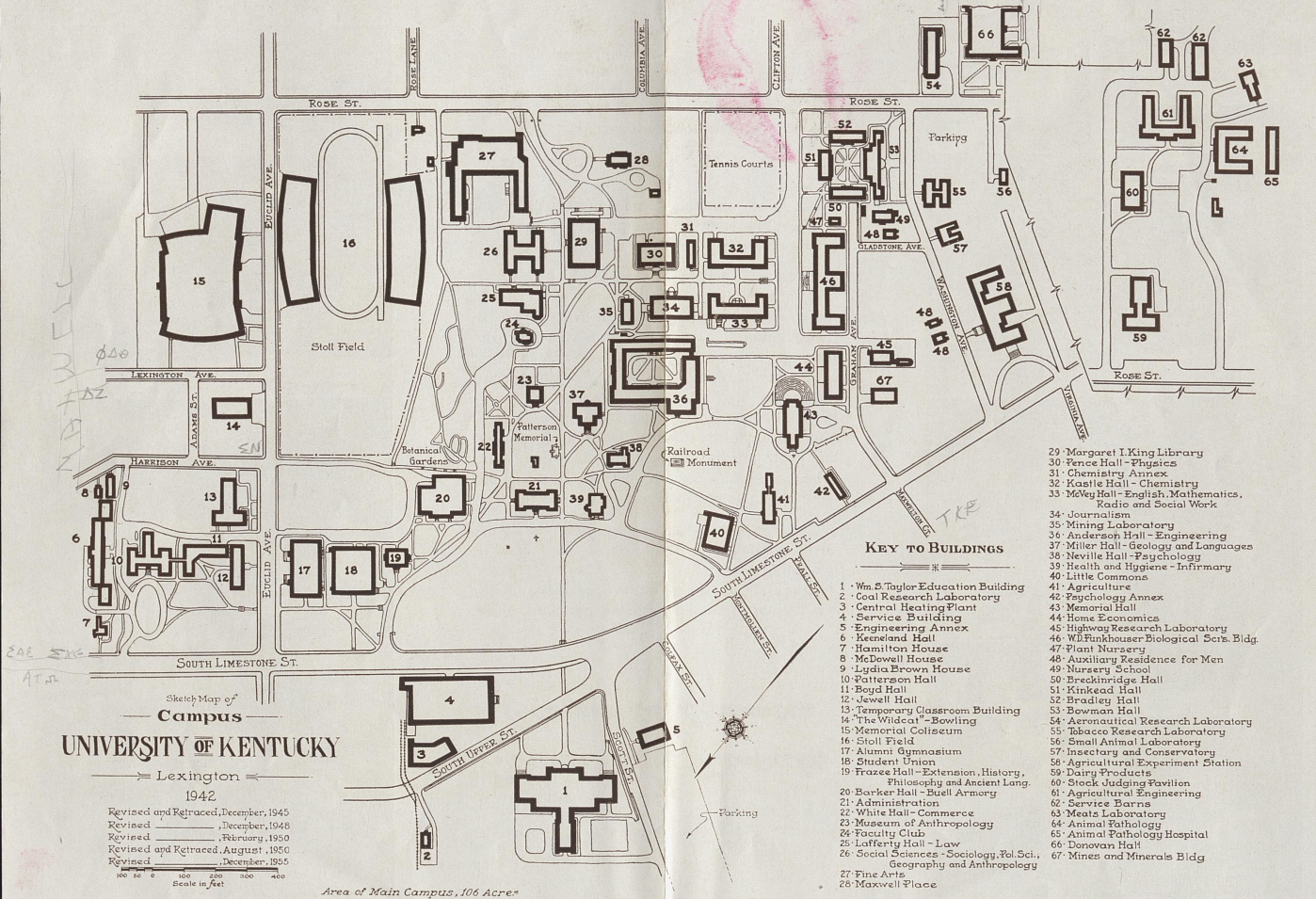
