

Add-drop starts tomorrow at coliseum

What could be one of your least favorite experiences of the year, the infamous add-drop session, will be held at Memorial Coliseum tomorrow.

Thousands of students will stand in line Tuesday waiting for a possible turn at rejection. But one way to reduce that possibility is to be prepared.

Students participating in add-drop should have their schedule card, a couple of pencils, and many optional

choices for the classes they're trying to add.

It's also important to remember to add before dropping. Advance registered students who want to change from one class to another should wait to drop their classes until the add transaction is completed. They should be sure to drop the old one so it will be available for anyone that might want to add it.

George Dexter, acting registrar and associate registrar, suggests that the students coming to add-drop bring their schedule cards that they received in the mail.

If the students do not have their schedule cards, they can pick up extra copies from the ticket office windows.

Students are encouraged to show up on time but will not be permitted to enter early; there will also be a late arrival line.

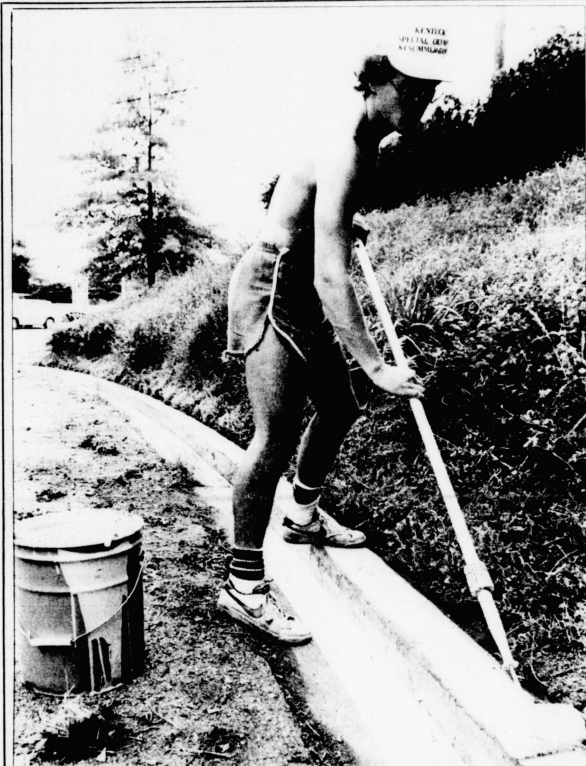
The College of Arts and Sciences will continue its add-drop sessions Wednesday at Memorial Coliseum and the other colleges at their respective deans' offices. After Wednesday Arts and Sciences departments will move to their respective offices.

The last day to withdraw from classes and be eligible for a full refund is Tuesday, Aug. 28, Dexter said. If dropping classes changes students' statuses from full-time to part-time or further reduces their part-time hours, they must drop before this date or lose 20 percent of the refund, Dexter said.

The last day to receive 80 percent of the refund or cancellation of fees is Sept. 5, Dexter said. Students must take their copy of the add-drop slip to the registrar's office to request refunds or cancellation of fees.

News roundup: UK sees new personnel, policies and crime

A Chinese graduate student was murdered early in June in a laboratory in the Chemistry-Physics Building.

Lin-jung Chen, 31, was raped and strangled sometime between Friday, June 9 and Saturday, June 10 while working on a chemistry research project, Lexington police reported.

Police sought Lexington resident Elzie Alexander Morton, 31, in connection with the crime. Morton was arrested in California late last month. He was extradited to Lexington, where he will stand trial.

About 300 students who registered to vote last spring on campus may not be eligible to vote in the upcoming election.

A voter registration drive sponsored by the Student Government Association may not have been valid, according to officials at the Lexington Voter Registration Office.

Mike Bush, former political affairs director for the Student Government Association, was in charge of the drive.

Bush said that on April 27 he took registration cards and a list of registered students to the Voter Registration Office.

Officials at the office denied receiving the registration cards from SGA or any other campus organization on that day.

The deadline for processing registration cards was April 30.

Students who registered in the Spring drive should contact the Voter Registration Office on North Upper Street to verify their registration.

Male college students who have not registered for the draft will not be eligible to receive federal scholarship aid.

A Supreme Court ruling this summer upheld the controversial Solomon amendment, enacted by Congress two years ago to combat widespread noncompliance with the draft registration requirements.

David Stockham, UK director of financial aid, said his department has attached a draft registration

sheet to financial aid forms for the past two years.

University officials are encouraging students to be re-vaccinated for rubella and measles because of recent outbreaks of the two diseases.

In 1983, outbreaks were reported at the University of Indiana, Cornell University and Dartmouth College, among others.

A faulty vaccine that was used between 1963 and 1969 is the cause for the sudden epidemics, according to Frank Cascio, director of student health services.

After 1969, a live virus was used which does provide lasting immunity.

A two-week immunization clinic will be held at the student health service in the latter part of September. A processing fee of \$5 will be charged.

Lexington-Fayette Urban County Councilman Robert A. Babbage has been named assistant to President Otis A. Singletary.

Babbage's primary job will be tying up loose ends with the Maxwell Gluck Equine Research Center, a \$9-million facility announced last year by the University.

He was chosen for the \$42,000-a-year job from a field of more than 100 applicants, according to Singletary.

Babbage's business experience includes a partnership in Leppert-Babbage Financing Group. He also is president of Keen-Babbage Management.

The University Bookstore has been leased to Follett College Stores Corp. of Illinois.

Nearly \$400,000 in student scholarship money will be available annually, said Jack Blanton, vice chancellor for administration.

Follett will rent the store for \$600,000 annually and will purchase the inventory for an estimated \$1,000,000.

Exact plans for the scholarships have not been made, however, Blanton said the awards will be based on merit and need.

Alton Coleman, charged with a

string of eight murders in the Midwest, is also a suspect in the July abduction of a UK researcher.

Oline Carmichael, who is doing post-doctorate research at UK's Appalachian Center, was kidnapped at gunpoint from his Lexington motel.

Carmichael was locked in the trunk of his car and driven to a Dayton, Ohio park by his abductors.

Coleman and his companion, Debra Brown, were charged in the kidnapping.

The Pi Kappa Alpha Fraternity house sustained damages worth an estimated \$100,000 in a fire early this summer.

The fire began in a room on the second floor, according to Captain Paul Oliver, Lexington fire inspector. Oliver said the cause was determined to be a smoldering cigarette stuffed into a chair.

There were no injuries, but all personal belongings on the floor were ruined by fire, water and smoke.

Jack Dulworth, a finance senior, became the first Kentucky student to be appointed to two consecutive terms in the Council on Higher Education this summer.

Dulworth, who is also the first UK student to serve on the council, was appointed by Gov. Martha Layne Collins in June. The governor appoints a student from nominations received from the student body presidents at the eight state universities.

Controversy among the student body presidents resulted last April when Dulworth was nominated for a second term by University of Louisville president Frank Jendryak.

David Bradford, 1983-84 UK Student Government Association president, said he considered the position to be a rotating job and did not support Dulworth's nomination.

Dulworth said he was very pleased to be appointed to his second term. His experience with the council will be an advantage, he said.

"My experience puts me a step ahead of any student that could have been appointed to the council. I feel I have a grasp of the issues and I know the ropes."

SAB plans to entertain and enlighten campus

The Student Activities Board plans all-campus entertainment at UK from such events as Homecoming Week and guest speakers to movies and concerts.

Louis Straub, SAB president, wants students to realize the variety of activities SAB sponsors, especially in the upcoming semester.

"I want students to get excited about UK," Straub said, "so they can be aware of what SAB can offer them."

Straub hopes to get the semester off on the right track with a revised version of the Wildcat Welcome Week. The two-day affair starts today in the free speech area between the Student Center and the Addition. Campus administrators and college deans will be present to meet and mingle with students. Also students interested in participating in various campus organizations can sign up at representative tables. The said Og Pots will perform during the luncheon time both days.

The Back-to-School Bash featuring The Look will take place on Sept. 7 in the Student Center parking lot. The Bash will be the first outdoor dance in 15 years, Straub said. "The Empire Strikes Back" will be presented at a special showing in the Worsham Theater that night.

The Fall Free-For-All, a scholarship fund-raiser for Collegians at Academic Excellence, is planned for Sept. 22 to replace the traditional UK Fall Festival.

WKQQ will promote the spectacle

which will feature 20 merchants giving away free items such as food, drinks and hats. One of the day's highlights will be "the world's largest" Twister game organized by the Milton Bradley Company. Live bands will perform all day.

Homecoming Week begins Oct. 1 with a fashion show and the traditional Wildcat Roar. The week is capped off with what Straub describes as a "phenomenal" halftime show at the night game with Rutgers on Oct. 6.

Soviet dissident Alex Ginzberg will speak on Soviet-American relations Oct. 30, Straub said. The speech, co-sponsored with Student Government Association, will occur one week before the presidential elections.

The Spotlight Jazz Series marks its seventh season with three concerts this fall in Memorial Hall. The season features Pieces of a Dream on Sept. 21, saxophonist Paquito D'Rivera on Nov. 2, and Grammy Award winner Wynton Marsalis on Dec. 1, according to Chester Grundy, director of Minority Student Affairs.

Tickets go on sale Sept. 1 at the Student Center Ticket Office. The first two concerts are \$9.00 and the Marsalis concert is \$12.00. Students can buy the three-concert package for \$22.00, and the general public can buy the package for \$26.00, Grundy said.

The Worsham Theater will show movies such as "The Big Chill," "Romancing the Stone," "Splash" and "Terms of Endearment." The ticket price is \$1.75.

Arts and Sciences adds new sequences

Five new classes and four sequences to satisfy general studies requirements have been created by the College of Arts and Sciences, according to John Christopher, associate dean of the college.

Courses in chemistry, English, history and religious studies will now join such "perennial favorites" as freshman level psychology and biology classes as students' preferred ways to fulfill general studies requirements, Christopher said.

Elements of College Chemistry, CHE 104-105, is a sequence of new

classes that is now acceptable as a fulfillment of the physical sciences requirement.

"The College of Nursing requested it. They didn't feel they wanted their people to take the 105-107 sequence," said Robert Guthrie, chairman of the chemistry department. The new sequence is a response to the many students, not only nursing students, who felt the CHE 105-107 sequence was too in-depth for their needs. The classes will be geared toward "anyone who simply wants an introduction to chemistry and doesn't plan to go any further in the chemistry sequence," according to Guthrie.

The English department's American literature sequence, ENG 251-252, has been approved toward completion of the general studies requirement in the humanities. The sequence supplements existing courses in European and Western literature.

"It seemed to us... that this was a reasonable alternative for students to take," said Thomas Blues, acting summer chairman of the department.

According to Blues, pre-registering students have responded enthusiastically to the change. "I think that the sections for fall are virtually full," he said.

Christopher also said that MA 131,

Mathematics for Life Sciences, is currently undergoing evaluation by the College of Arts and Sciences.

The first half of a popular mathematics choice for life science majors, MA 131, may be eliminated by the college, according to Christopher, because the course is similar in content to another mathematics class, MA 123, Elementary Calculus.

The new sequence, MA 123-132, will be available "while we undergo the change proposed," he said.

Introduction to Comparative Religion, RES 130, is a new class in the religious studies area. The course will offer a scientific evaluation and comparison of religions of the world.
