

THIS INDENTURE Made this 26th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred and five between Jacob Landman and Catharine his wife

of the County of Fayette and Commonwealth of Kentucky, of the one part, and David Watts and Commonwealth aforesaid, of the other part, Witnesseth:

That the said Jacob Landman & Catharine his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty two pounds ten shillings Current Money of Kentucky, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and confirm, unto the said David Watts his Heirs and Assigns, all that Tract or parcel of Land, situate and being in the County of Fayette on the waters of Boones Creek containing twenty one acres ^{more or less} ~~and~~ bounded as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a Buckeye and running North Eighty Seven poles to a sugar tree sticking, thence East thirty Eight and an half poles to two sugar trees come to James Dulin, thence with Dulin line Eighty seven poles thence thirty Eight and an half poles to the Beginning.

Together with all and singular, the premises thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining: To have and to hold the Land hereby conveyed, with the appertinances, unto the said David Watts his Heirs and Assigns, forever: And the said Jacob Landman & Catharine his wife for themselves their Heirs, Executors and Administrators, the aforesaid Tract of Land and Premises, unto the said David Watts his Heirs or Assigns, against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons, whatsoever, the aforesaid premises and their appertinances do and will warrant and forever defend, by these presents.
