STILL IN THE WOODS THERE I GREW UP THERE WERE SOME SCHOOLS, SO CALLED, THERE WAS ABSOLUTELY NOTHING TO EXCITE AMBITION FOR EDUCATION OF COURSE WHEN I CAME OF AGE I DID NOT KNOW MUCH STILL SOMEHOW, I COULD READ WRITE AND CIPHER TO THE RULE OF THREE, BUT THAT WAS ALL. THE LITTLE ADVANCE I NOW HAVE UPON THIS STORE OF EDUCATION I HAVE PICKED UP FROM TIME TO TIME UNDER THE PRESSURE OF NECESSITY A. LINCOLN.
