Under the current system the members of a very few chapters pay \$12 and \$14 cach for the formals given, and everyone else who attends pays nothing. In other words, a few (100 or 150) Greeks pay, ... and everybody plays.

To sum up: under the current system fraternity men and women are doomed to hear only second-rate hands for the rest of their school lives, a small number of Greeks are soaked unmerefulful; and a handful of chapters are accorded the dubious honor of having played host to the University. It is a wasteful, inefficient, unusound system and it is high time it was done away with,

The principal objection to the proposed plan seem to arise from the larger fraternities, who claim their rights are infringed upon.
