## AMERICAN REVOLUTION SYMPOSIUM

A Historical Symposium on the American Revolution as it is related to the southern states, i.e. 1750 to 1800, will be held Oct. 10-12 at the Hilton Inn in Lexington. The symposium is sponsored jointly by the Kentucky Historical Events Celebration Commission and the Federal Archives and Records Center. Those interested may see a copy of the complete program for the three day event in the Director's Office.

## MRAP STUDY

The Management Review and Analysis Study Team composed of John Bryant (chairperson) Ellen Baxter, Jennifer Coffman, Adelle Dailey, Judy Fugate, Jean Graef, Bill Marshall, and Steve Langston (Professor of Mathematics; assistant to Dr. Cochran) held its first meeting on September 6, 1974. Since then weekly meetings have been established. These are held on Tuesday at 1:30. The MRAP study is nearing the end of Phase I in which the Team has been examining the methods that are to be used to conduct the review.

Phases I, II, and III should be completed by Thanksgiving with a report on needs prepared in December and presented to the Management and Staff for review. The analytical phases, i.e., having task forces review such items as planning, budgeting, staff development, organization, and other operations of the Library, will begin shortly after the Christmas break. For further information concerning the various phases, see the reverse side of this sheet.

A questionnaire concerning some of the primary issues to which the Team should address its attention will be sent in the near future to the department heads. After this data has been received, the Team will hold an all day work session on October 16.

The Team will be making progress reports via the Green Bean on a regular basis. Also, other means of communication will be developed as the study progresses.


