Relief food bank infested with rats

COLUMBIA, S.C. — Rats' nests found in a food warehouse threatened to leave Thanksgiving tables short of food for South Carolina's needy, as food banks in two states scrambled to replace 1,000 tons of possibly contaminated tiems.

The U.S. Agriculture Department and the Food and Drug Administration locked down the affected CRK Entreprises warehouse in Columbia last week. But not before some items were sent to food banks in South Carolina and Charotte. N.C., and on to families preparing for Thanksgiving.

CRK President Maurice Webber said inspectors who checked in June found no evidence of vermin at the warehouse. The rats found last week probably came from nearby fields to escape the cold weather, he said.

NEW YORK — Ending months of speculation, Hillary Rodham Clinton said yesterday she is seeking the Senate seat from New York. "The answer is yes," she told supporters. "I intend to run." She left no room for doubt in a news conference later. "It's time to get moving and get state and campaigning." Mrs. Clinton said she would make the campaign official in an anouncement early next year. The first land yan her advisers engineered the announcement yesterday to end speculation that she was having second thoughts about the race.

Clinton urges Kosovo forgiveness

UROSEVAC. Yugoslavia — In a plen met with scant applause and silent stares, President Clinton told ethnic Albanians in Kosovo yesterday that "you must try" to forgive Serb neighbors and stop punishing them for the terror campaign of Yugoslav President Slobodan Milosevic. "The time for fighting has passed," Clinton said. Guarded by armed troops and tanks, Clinton ended a 10-day European tour by sweeping into wartorn Kosovo to urge reconciliation instead of revenge and to give a Thanksgiving boost to U.S. peacekeeping forces. Accompanied by his daughter, Chelsea, Clinton went to Camp Bondsteel, home for most of the 6,000 U.S. troops in Kosovo.

Consumers' web complaints increase

WASHINGTON — Auto sales, auto repair and home improvement services still generate the most complaints from consumers, but gripes about Internet-related service, purchases and auctions are rising steadily, a survey shows. The eighth annual survey by the National Association of Consumer Agency Administrators and the Consumer Federation of America also shows a huge increase - 1,037 percent last year - in complaints about "cramming," the practice of padding telephone or credit card bills with unauthorized charges, typically from third parties.
