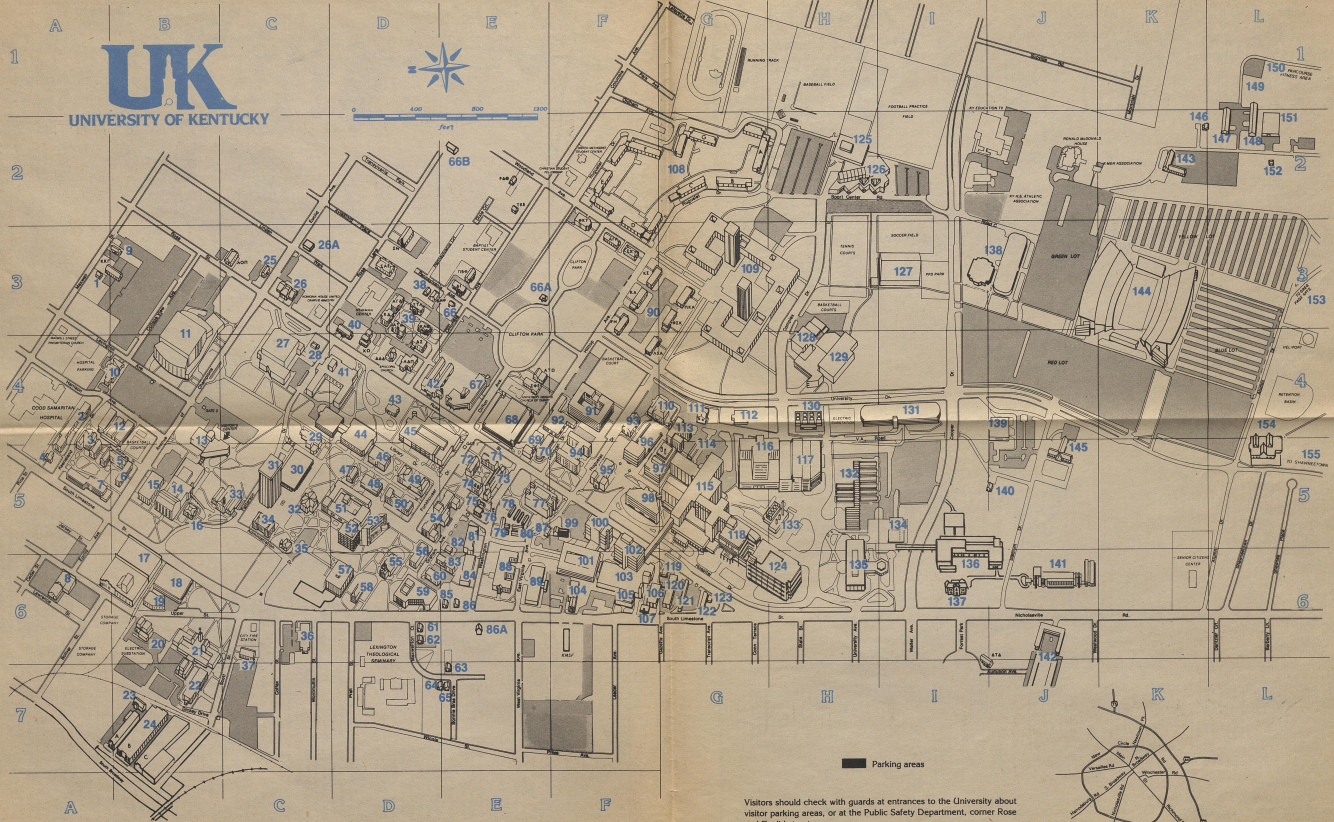

About the University . . .

History and governance

The University of Kentucky was founded in 1865 under the provisions of the Morrill Land-Grant Act.

For the first 40 years, enrollment remained small, but by the turn of the century the University was becoming one of the most important institutions in the state.

UK took its present name in 1916 and at the same time assumed the responsibility of being the state's principal institution for teaching, research and service.

The University of Kentucky is governed by a 20-member Board of Trustees.

The campus

The University of Kentucky's 679-acre campus is located just south of downtown Lexington, Ky., which has a population of more than 210,000.

Academic programs

The University of Kentucky has 17 academic colleges. They are: Arts and Sciences . . . Agriculture . . . Engineering . . . Business and Economics . . . Education . . . Home Economics . . . Library and Information Sciences . . . Social Work . . . Architecture . . . Communications . . . Fine Arts . . . Law . . . Medicine . . . Dentistry . . . Nursing . . . Allied Health Professions . . . Pharmacy . . .

On the graduate level, 92 programs lead to the master's degree and 57 to the doctorate in The Graduate School.

Research

The University of Kentucky library system contains more than two million volumes and is the state's only complete depository for United States, United Nations, European Communities and Canadian government publications.

The University receives about \$60 million in external support for research and other projects each year. Major areas of externally funded research are in the medical sciences (including cancer and aging), biotechnology, biomedical engineering, engineering sciences, mathematical and computational sciences, agricultural sciences and various social sciences. Both basic and applied research in these areas receive substantial external support.

An IBM 3090-600J supercomputer is among the resources of the UK Computing Center.

Faculty

UK's full-time faculty numbers 1,566 on the Lexington campus and the Medical Center.

Admissions and enrollment

Admission to the University of Kentucky is offered to students who demonstrate the ability to compete in an academically demanding environment. Students will be automatically admitted if they have no previous college work and their standardized test scores (ACT or SAT), high school grades and curriculum predict successful academic performance as UK freshmen. Notices of admission to UK are sent to students on a continuous basis throughout the school year.

Approximately 20 percent of the UK freshman class may be selected from applicants who do not meet the requirements for automatic acceptance. In addition to standardized test scores, grades, and high school curriculum, the Admissions Office will consider such factors as extracurricular activities, out-of-class accomplishments, personal achievement, and the geographic region in which the student lives. Admissions decisions for delayed applicants begin after February 15.

Tuition and financial aid

The 1990-91 undergraduate tuition is \$855 per semester for residents of Kentucky and \$2,355 for non-residents. Room and

board for the school year is \$2,466 or higher, depending on the meal plan selected.

More than 55 percent of UK's students receive financial aid which amounts to some \$41 million annually.

Student body

Enrollment on UK's Lexington campus totals about 23,000. Students are from every Kentucky county, from 49 other states and the District of Columbia and from 84 foreign countries.

About 5,300 students live in UK's residence halls. About 2,700 UK students belong to fraternities and sororities and a large number of them live in the residences of these groups.

Alumni

The University has about 106,000 alumni around the world with about 24,000 paid members in UK's National Alumni Association, including 8,883 life members. There are 60 active alumni clubs across the nation, with 32 of them in Kentucky and 28 outside the state from California to New York. There are four "young alumni" groups in Kentucky.

Athletics

In athletics, UK has a total of 18 sports -- 9 men's and 9 women's sports -- competing on the highest level of national collegiate competition.

The Wildcat basketball team plays in the downtown Lexington Civic Center's Rupp Arena under the direction of Coach Rick Pitino. UK has won five NCAA championships, two NCAA runner-up trophies, two NIT winning trophies, and 37 Southeastern Conference championships.

Wildcat football teams play in the 58,000-seat Commonwealth Stadium on campus and in recent years have won two bowl games and shared in a SEC championship. The team is coached by Bill Curry.

Community colleges

The 14 community colleges in Kentucky are an important part of the University of Kentucky. These two-year colleges, located throughout the state, offer the first two years of the baccalaureate program, associate technical degrees, and a wide variety of continuing education and community service programs. Enrollment at the community colleges statewide is more than 36,000 students.

Medical Center

UK's Chandler Medical Center has a wide range of programs in education and research. The five colleges -- Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy and Allied Health Professions -- have more than 2,700 students pursuing bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees in health-related fields.

The Medical Center also has the 461-bed University of Kentucky Hospital as part of its teaching and service programs.

What to see

Free guided bus tours are conducted at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. weekdays from the Visitor Center located in the UK Student Center. Saturday tours are at 11 a.m. September through April only. Special group tours may be arranged by calling 606-257-3595.

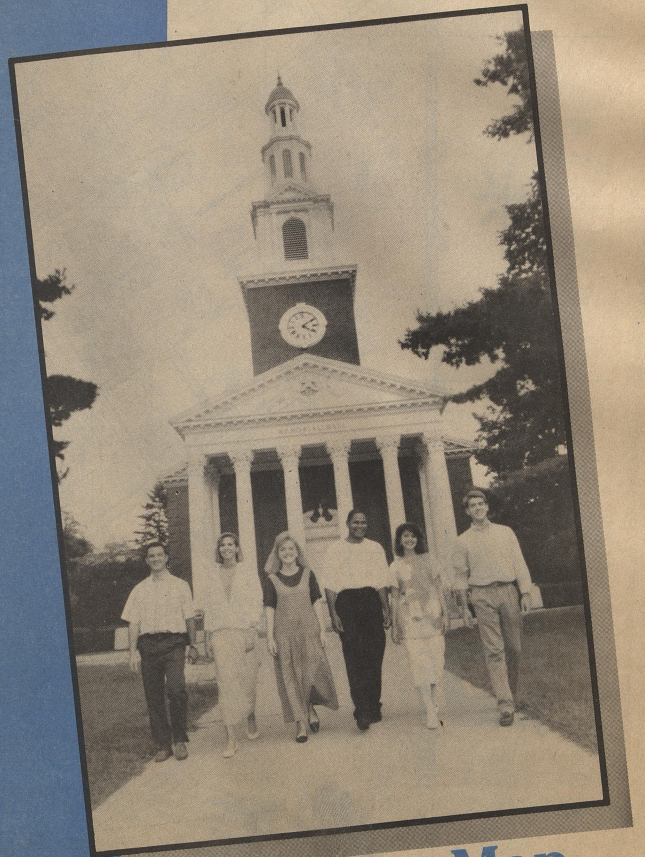
The UK Art Museum, located in the West Wing of the Singletary Center for the Arts at the corner of Rose Street and Euclid Avenue, is open daily except Mondays and University holidays, from noon to 5 p.m. (4:30 p.m. in summer).

The UK Museum of Anthropology is open Mondays through Fridays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. It is located in Lafferty Hall on the campus. A cultural history of Kentucky is one of the featured exhibits.

Visitors to the UK campus may also want to take advantage of the breathtaking view of Lexington and the University campus from the 18th floor of the Patterson Office Tower on campus. It is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Mondays through Fridays.
