# Exploring Goodkind's Naked Empire

Though the heady anticipation of Harry Potter has lost its potency and The Lord of the Rings: The Return of the King doesn't hit theaters until December; the fantasy genre continues to thrive.

Thanks, in part to author Terry Goodkind, whose own brand of fantasy deals with Confessors, gars and a very rare person with a unique sword.

The author will be significant of the second of the second

Goodkind, who burst onto the fantasy scene in 1994 with Wizard's First Rule,

has created a universe in which truth and uncondi-tional love are constantly dogged by greed and lust for power. His novels examine heartache, triumph and hu-mility, while combining tra-ditional elements of fantasy: dragons, magic, wizards and an epic quest for good in the face of evil.

It's the universal themes that Goodkind seamlessly weaves into his work that defies one simple label, such as fantasy.

"Readers make a huge mistake if they come to my books because they think they will just be reading about magic," Goodkind said in an interview. "That's like going to a rock concert just to see hairdos. To think that these stories are about magic is to miss the true magic of the story."

Naked Empire continues the saga of his two central characters, Richard Rahl, the Seeker of Truth, and Mother

Confessor Kahlan Annell.

The series began with Kahlan's character and grew from there.

"It really became a haunting experience," Goodkind said. "As soon as I started writing Wizard's First Rule, I knew writing was my calling. For found something to which I truly want to dedicate my life.

Writing takes up most of Goodkind's time, sometimes up to thours each day. If year a sound it is the same of t

guage for his novels (High D'Haran), but also drew the map of Richard and Kahlan's world, which is included in the books.

"Art helps me with my writing," Goodkind said. "I think it helps me bring texture and life to my (work)." His courtesy to readers is apparent as well.

# Coach Mo wants GymKats on next level

From Little to Muhammad: Former Assistant Coach Muhammad to take on role as GymKats head coach

As Mitch Barnhart and staff prepare for another exciting year with UK athletics, they have one more coaching change to add to the lineup. Former UK gymnastics assistant coach Hajile "Mo" Muhammad John Shickie DeMoss, Rich Brooks and John Cohen as one of UK's newest head coached. Leah Little resigned from the program in April after 28 years of leading the team from club status to Division I competitors. Little built the program from the ground up

Coach Mo, who has been with the GymKats since fall 1997, knew he wanted the job, but also knew that he would have to apply just like everyone else. Muhammad graduated from the University of Houston in 1995 with a degree in leangineering. Though he has yet to apply his degree to his coach for 22 years, 12 of which were spent as a clinician at regional roas.

Little's legacy at UK leaves big shoes for Muhammad to fill. In her 28 years at UK, Little created a club sport that advanced to a variety sport in 1980 due to Title IX laws. In the past 23 years, the GymKats have reached the NCAA regionals 16 times and Little was named SEC Coach of the Year twice.

Muhammad acknowledges that he has a tough path to follow, but has set his hopes high and believes he can fulfill what is needed of him.

"I plan on picking up



# Kobe website is unscrupulous

A website has surfaced after the accusation from a 19-year-old woman that Kobe Bryant sexually assaulted her in a Colorado hotel in which she worked.

Though this website tries to depict itself as a site devoted to fighting for basic rights guaranteed by the constitution for the sake of Bryant, the real motivation behind this site is to reap money from this newsworthy – and for some – emotional issue. The site sells merchandise ranging from tshirts to thongs with the imprinted words "Free Kobe." Most of the merchandise sells in the 820 price range.

The site has had 646,503 total visits since its creation on July 22, 2003. It averages over 80,000 his per day. In one day, if 10 percent of the individuals who visit for Free Kobe site purchase a t-shirt for twenty dollars, the site owners accumulate \$160,000. In a week the site would amass over a million dollars if 8,000 t-shirts were sold everyday.

But, not to worry. The creators of the website have donated over \$1,000 to support gender equality in sports.

This website is capitalism at its finest or worst, depending on one's outlook. The creators of the site will accumulate millions of dollars by taking advantage of a sensitive situation. The site is using Bryant's fan base and his appeal to invoke individuals to visit the site and purchase apparel to display their support for Bryant.


