

Some time during the month of June 1871  
I called in Company with W<sup>m</sup> J. Withers  
on J. B. Bowman with a view to adjust  
the difference between Bowman & Withers with  
the Church.

During this interview Withers stated  
to Bowman that Elders J. B. Melles & M<sup>c</sup>Garry  
had authorized and requested him to state to  
Bowman that they were willing and anxious  
to have an interview with him, that they  
might have an opportunity to remove from his  
mind the impression they understood he had  
that they had wronged or attempted to wrong  
him. - Withers stated that L. B. Melles  
authorizes him to say that Bowman was  
mistaken in supposing that he had ever  
wronged or attempted to wrong him - that  
he was satisfied that he could explain  
all that he has said and done to the  
satisfaction of Bowman, but that if he  
could not explain to the satisfaction of  
Bowman, and had done him any wrong
