Dear Sir

We would respectfully
call the attention of the Executive
Committee to the fact that J. B. Bowman
has failed to execute Bond as required
by the 4th section of the Charter of Ky
University and to notify you that he
has no right to perform the duties of
Treasurer until he has executed Bond
as the Charter requires - We expect you
to see that the Treasurer executes Bond
at once

We also notify you that we
shall contest the payment of any of
the funds of the University to Attorneys
or lobbyists in the contest now pending
before the Legislature to amend the Charter
and shall hold the Executive Committee and
the Treasurer to a strict accountability
for any use of the funds of the University
for the above purposes - The 4th section of
the Charter expressly provides that the
Treasurer shall pay out no money except
upon the order of the Board of Curators
endorsed by the President of the Board
