2nd If in the case and under the circumstances
above mentioned Shackelford Woolfson Stoddell
& myself cannot agree on the terms on which
the parties are to be restored to membership
in the Main Street, I am willing to take
the advice of two or more discreet brethren
to be mutually agreed on between Woolfson
Shackelford Stoddell & myself as to the terms
on which the parties or either or all of them
shall be restored to the fellowship & membership
of the Main Street Church, and to use
whatever of influence I may possess to
have the advice of the friends called in for
consultation accepted & carried out by the
Church in a regular meeting thereof.

basis and without delay, then in my opinion
