

Memo in care of Herndon by Ky. C. E. Society

On the 14th of December 1868 the Will of Henry
Foster was Probated in Fayette County Court
By it he devised $\frac{1}{3}$ of his land to his wife
Mary Foster for life & at her death to be
equally divided between Orphan School, Ky. C. E.
Society & Mary Miller - a certain tract of land
to Charles Jane & Sally Ross, 17 acres on
opposite side of Todd Road known as the
Wallace place containing 17 acres more or less
The remainder of his land to be divided as follows
80 acres to Emma Herndon
65 " to Female Orphan School as aforesaid
To Ky. C. E. Society the remainder of his land on
which resides, containing 20 acres be the same
more or less -

By a codicil he devised 12 acres since
purchase of Erich Bacon to Emma Herndon

On 27th of Feb 1869 under the order of the Fayette
County Court C. E. Division divided the land
as follows, J. L. Darnaby Surveyor of the C
surveying it Sept 9th March 1869 said division comprised
80 acres as dower to Mrs Foster
92 " to Mrs Emma Herndon
17 A 1 R $24\frac{20}{100}$ Poles to Chas W Jane & Sally Ross
65 acres to Female Orphan School
39 $\frac{3}{4}$ acres to Ky Christian E Society
The whole tract by this survey contain 294 a $24\frac{20}{100}$ poles
