To the Sheriff of Claiborne County Greeting

We Command you that you Summon Robert R. Shaukey, that he be and personally before the Judge of our Circuit Court of Claiborne County at a Circuit Court to be holden at the Court House in the Town of Port Gibson on the 4th Monday of May next (1841.) then and there to answer as a Garnishee in a certain Cause of Garnishment therein pending wherein John Stamps is plaintiff and John D. Vetter defendant.

Whether he is indebted to the said defendant John D. Vetter and in what Sum or Sums and what effects of said defendant he has in his hands or possession and whether he knows of any person or persons who are indebted to the said defendant and what Sum or Sums, and this he shall in no wise omit under the penalty of the law in such Case made and provided
