This Indenture made and entered into on this
thirteenth day of November A.D. 1843. between
Samuel Coburn (Trustee) of the County of Claib-
orne and State of Mississippi of the first part and
Robert R. Sharkey - of the County of Claiborne
and State aforesaid of the second part. Witnesseth

That whereas on the 7th day of May A.D. 1840 White
Turpin executed and delivered a certain deed of
conveyance of certain property both real and per-
sonal to the said Coburn, and Joseph Humber
(and only accepted by said Coburn) in trust and
confidence for certain uses and purposes fully
set forth in said deed now of record in the of-
fice of the clerk of the Probate Court of Claib-
orne County in Deed Book V. pages 325 to 331.
inclusive to which reference is hereby made and
the same is intended to be taken and made
part of these presents. And whereas, to carry out
the intention of the parties and to execute said
trust according to the true intent and mean-
ing of said deed of trust it became necessary to
sell all and singular the property therein men-
tioned and described Now be it known that
I said Coburn trustee as aforesaid at the request
of the party of the third part in said deed did
on May 10 1843 cause to be inserted and published
in the Port Gibson correspondent a publick newspa-
