

This Indenture made this 22nd day of May A D 1872 between Sarah Sharkey of the City of Lexington and State of Kentucky party of the first part, and Charles F. Clint of the City of Jackson and State of Mississippi of the second part Witnesses:

That said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, one thousand of which has been paid in hand by said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for the other one thousand said Clint has executed his promissory note of even date herewith payable sixty days after date, and bearing interest from date until paid at the rate of ten per cent per annum to secure the payment of which a special lien is hereby asserted on said land herein after described, has granted, bargained, sold & conveyed and does hereby grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Charles F. Clint, his heirs and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Hinds and State of Mississippi adjoining the Northern Corporation line of the City of Jackson, and more particularly designated and described as follows to wit:

All of the 38 1/4 of the 30 1/4 of Section Thirty Four (34) Township Six Range One East, that big part of the public road leading from Jackson to Canton Mississippi; and also all of the West half of 31 1/4 of the 30 1/4 of Section Thirty Five (35) Township Six Range One East, containing Forty acres, be the same more or less.

To Have and to Hold said lands with all their appurtenances, to the use, proper use, benefit and behoof of him the said Charles F. Clint, his heirs, and
